

# Easter Egg

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Time to Complete: Approximately 20 minutes    Level: Easy



### GETTING STARTED

**IMPORTANT:** You will need to print the outside of the Easter egg first. Then, you will place the printed pages back into the paper tray to print the inside of the Easter egg.

#### Materials:

- Metal-edged ruler
- Butter knife
- Scissors or X-ACTO knife
- Cutting mat (optional)
- Multipurpose glue

- 1 Score all the pieces: Using a ruler as a guide, run the back side of a butter knife firmly along all the dashed lines. Fold inward along all score lines.

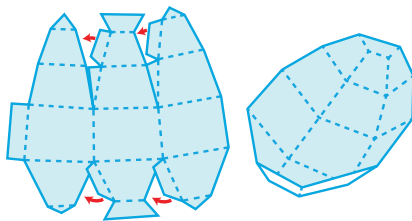


- 2 Using scissors or an X-ACTO knife and cutting mat, cut out pieces along solid lines.

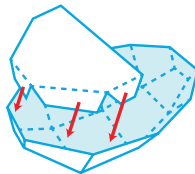


### ASSEMBLE YOUR EASTER EGG

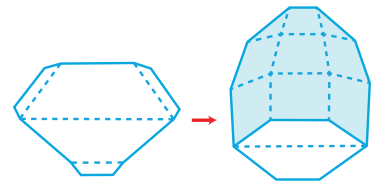
- 3 Assemble each half of the egg by gluing all the tabs in place.



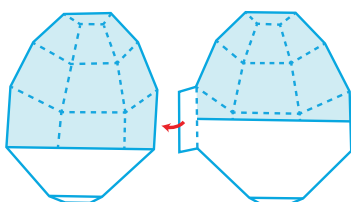
- 4 Glue the basket inside the half of the egg with the hinge.



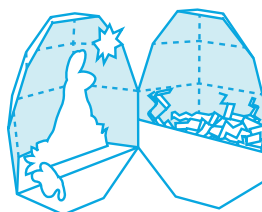
- 5 Glue the stage inside the other half of the egg.



- 6 Place glue on the hinge and attach to the other half of the egg, where indicated below.



- 7 Finishing touches: 1) Cut the grass into thin strips, crinkle, and place in basket. 2) Glue the bunny onto the stage. 3) Add sun and butterfly embellishments where desired. 4) Place a special gift in the basket, like candy or other small treats.



- 8 Assemble the band by gluing each tab to the end of the opposite strip. Slide the band onto the egg. You're done!
